## INVITATION FOR NEGOTIATED PROCUREMENT

### Procurement, Supply and Delivery of 678 pcs 5.56MM, 30 rounds Magazine

In view of two (2) failed public biddings, the Police Regional Office 1 (PRO 1)-Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) invites interested bidders to participate in the negotiation for the Project, **“Procurement, Supply and Delivery of 678 pcs 5.56MM, 30 rounds Magazine”**, in accordance with Section 53.1 of the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (RA) 9184, otherwise known as the “Government Procurement Reform Act”. The PRO1, through the GAA FY 2020 as basis intends to apply the sum of Nine Hundred Eighty-three Thousand One Hundred Pesos (**Php983,100.00**) being the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) to payments under the contract for the Project.

To bid for this contract, the prospective bidders are required to submit their Eligibility, Technical and Financial components of its bids. Each bidder shall submit one envelope labeled as bid proposal containing three envelopes one (1) labeled as original while the other two are labeled as copy 1 and copy 2, respectively and the proof of compliance to the NAPOLCOM Standard Specifications.

Please be reminded that the GPPB issued Circular No. 07-2017 dated July 31, 2017 entitled “Deferment of the Implementation of Mandatory Submission of PhilGEPS Certificate of Registration and Membership” hence,



prospective bidders are required to submit the following Class "A" eligibility documents under Section 23.1(a) and 24.1(a) of the IRR of RA No. 9184, to wit:

- a. Registration Certificate;
- b. Mayor's/Business Permit or its equivalent document;
- c. Tax Clearance; and
- d. Audited Financial Statements.

In lieu of the above documents, prospective bidders may still submit their PhilGEPS Platinum Certificate of Registration and Membership at their option.

All proposals must be accompanied by a bid security in any of the acceptable forms and in the amount stated in Section 27 of the 2016 Revised IRR of RA 9184.

Suppliers who will submit the Lowest Financial Proposal will be considered and recommended for Bid Evaluation and Post Qualification. If found complying, said supplier will be recommended to the Head of Procuring Entity for the issuance of Notice of Award.

Proposals will be opened in the presence of the Bidders' representatives who choose to attend at the address above. Late proposals shall not be accepted.

The Police Regional Office 1 reserves the right to reject any and all bids, declare a failure of bidding, or not award the contract at any time prior to contract award in accordance with Section 41 of RA 9184 and its IRR, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders.
